7. What was unique about the administration of Governor James Murray in Quebec in 1763?

8. Why would this type of government be necessary in the circumstances of the time?

9. The British tried to Anglicize the French. What does this mean and how did they try to do it?

10. "...the Quebec Act is regarded as a kind of Magna Carta by the French in Canada." Explain this statement.

11. Upper Canada? Lower Canada? United Empire Loyalists? Explain how they are connected.

12. Explain the difference between a system of oligarchic government and a system of responsible government.

13. Canadian Confederation was the result of internal political deadlock and external threat. Explain.

14. Where and when were the three conferences that led to Confederation and what was decided at each conference?

15. Briefly describe the separation of powers between the federal and provincial governments.

17. Canada has a bicameral legislature. What does this mean?

18. What is “manifest destiny?” What effect did it have on Canadian affairs?
